RESPONDING

How does Vic feel on the deck? (hot)

What does Vic drop on the deck? (his socks)

Who snags Vic's sock? (A dog snags it.)

Who runs and bumps into Cass? (Vic does)

What kind of dog does Cass pick up first? (a slim dog)

What color is the sock the slim dog has? (pink)

What color is Vic's sock? (red)

What color dog does Cass lift up next? (She lifts up a black dog.)

Does the black dog have Vic's sock with dots on it? (No, it doesn't.)

Which dog has Vic's sock? (The fat dog has it.)

How does Cass catch the fat dog? (She spins fast and grabs it.)

Does Vic get his sock back? (Yes, he does.)

Would you like to be a dog walker? (answers will vary)
